When produce must be tithed (1-4)

- עוֹנַת הַמַּעֲשָׂרוֹת ע
- **✓** When the obligation begins
 - גְּמֵר מְלָאכָה Brought into אָמַר הָ
 - תְּרוֹמְה separated Sold
 - Cooked, pickled or salted
- עראי ער and אֲכִילַת אֲרָאי and אֲכִילַת
 - Fixed meal
 - שַׁבַּת instigates the obligation

Produce which is replanted (5.1-5.2)

✓ Tithing it if it's ready to eat

Buying from or selling to one who doesn't tithe (5.3-5.8)

- ✓ Not causing an עם הָאָרֶץ to eat untithed produce
- **✓** Buying a field from a non-Jew
